4. REPLACEMENT OF A RESIGNING DIRECTOR

Vice President Brad Ross indicated he will be resigning following the September 13, 2023 Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors. On August 24, 2023 and pursuant to Elections Code section 1780(c), the Board voted to fill the vacancy created by VP Ross' departure by appointment. The Board will consider applicants for the vacancy, and

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potentially appoint a replacement to fill the seat vacated by VP Ross. The term for office for the seat being vacated runs through 2024. Applicants will be given three minutes to summarize their application and reasons for wanting to serve on the Board of Directors. Following the applicant's comments, Board members may ask questions of applicants. Following public comment, the Board will consider appointment and/or ask further questions of applicants.
